- 2. Ship Your Entries
 - Please use proper shipping methods for each product. If you are using wet ice, please wrap and seal twice to prevent leakage. Please include an entry form with your product information in the package. Overnight shipping is recommended. All entries must ship prepaid. All entries must arrive between June 18-19 (by 12 noon), 2023. Products may be transported by contestant rather than shipped.

Entry Rules

- All entries must be submitted by a company/manufacturer of 100% Golden Guernsey Milk Products.
- There are no restrictions on the number of entries per company.

- For all contest categories, the evaluator reserves the right to move product that appears misclassified into the appropriate product class
- All products need to be properly labeled, with ingredients and product name included.

<u>Cheese Entries</u> Cheeses must be submitted in at least 2 packages 8 oz .each <u>Butter Entries</u> Butter entries must contain at least 1 pound. <u>Fluid Milk</u> Each entry must contain at least 2 half gallons. <u>Half and Half/Creamer</u> Each entry must list product name and ingredients and must contain at least 2 quarts <u>Cream</u> Each entry must contain at least 2 quarts <u>Yogurt</u> Yogurt entries must contain at least 2 8oz containers or equivalent. There are no restrictions on fat level or sweetener. <u>Ice Cream</u> Entries must contain at least 1 half gallon of product and be received frozen.
